Participating members of the Center include faculty from the School of Engineering, the Department of Earth, Environmental & Planetary Sciences, the Division of Applied Mathematics, the Department of Physics and the Department of Ecology, Evolution, and Organismal Biology.

Fluid mechanics is an enabling science that describes dynamics over a huge range of scales - from the global scales of climate and ocean dynamics to the swimming of micron-scale bacteria. Fundamental research challenges involving fluid dynamics continue to emerge in engineering, the physical or biological sciences, mathematics and scientific computation.
